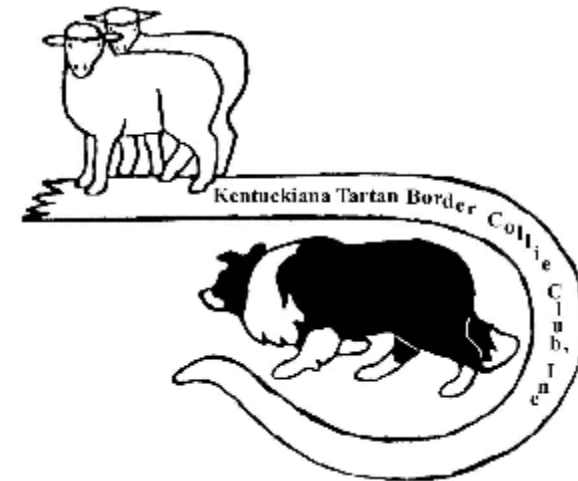

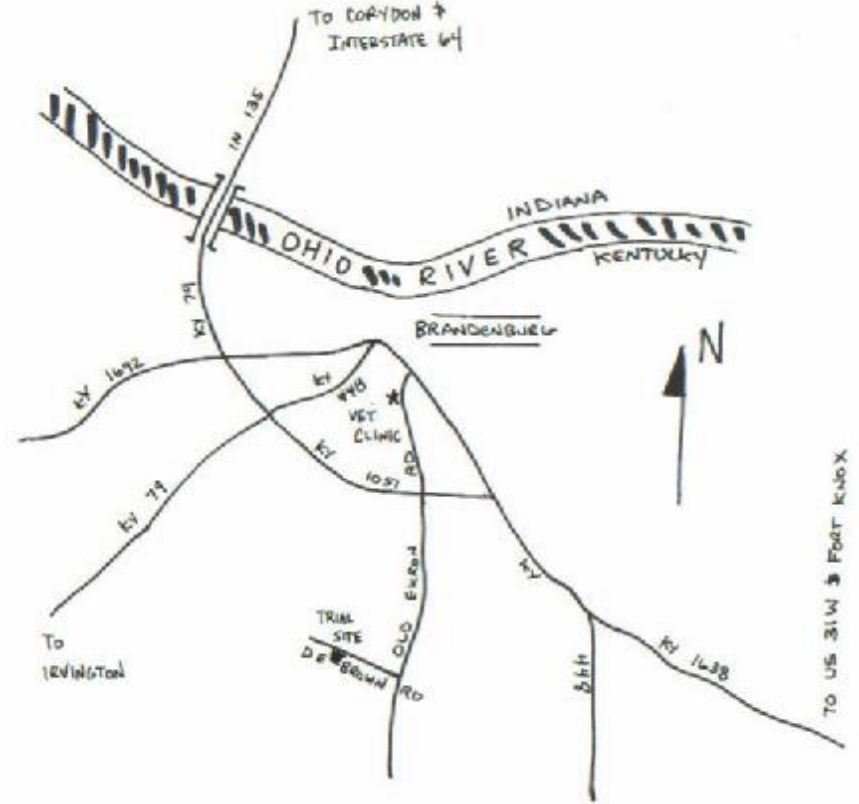
## Directions to Trial Site

### FROM THE NORTH AND WEST

Take Interstate 64 to the Corydon, Indiana exit (#105). Take Indiana 135 south across the Ohio River, where it becomes Kentucky 79. Follow Kentucky 79 south around the Brandenburg Bypass. Continue straight on the Bypass (Kentucky 1051) to Old Ekron Road, which is the corner with the Pamida store. Turn right onto Old Ekron Road, and go about 1.6 miles south to D E Brown Road. Turn right onto D E Brown Road. The Trial site is less than 0.5 miles on the left.

### FROM THE SOUTH AND EAST

From the north (Louisville) or south (Elizabethtown, Radcliff and Fort Knox), take U.S. Route 31W. In Muldraugh, turn at the stoplight onto Kentucky 1638. Go about 8.2 miles on 1638 until it comes to a "T" intersection. Turn right onto Kentucky 448 and go approximately 1.2 miles to the Brandenburg Bypass (Kentucky 1051) and turn left. The second stoplight is Old Ekron Road, which is the corner with the Pamida store. Turn left onto Old Ekron Road and go about 1.6 miles south, then turn right onto D E Brown Road. The Trial site is less than 0.5 miles on the left.

**DIRECTIONS TO HOSPITAL**

From the Trial site, follow D E Brown Road back to Old Ekron Road. Turn left on Old Ekron road and go to the Brandenburg Bypass (Kentucky 1051). Turn right on Kentucky 1051 until you reach Kentucky 448. Turn right on Kentucky 448 and travel about 1.2 miles to Kentucky 1638, where you turn left. Follow Kentucky 1638 approximately 8.2 miles until it ends on U.S. Route 31 W. Turn right on U.S. Route 31W and travel about 17 miles, past Fort Knox and through Radcliff to Elizabethtown. The hospital is on your right.

- All cancellations must be written or e-mailed and received by the Trial Secretary before the closing date.
- Drawing for running order will be held at the Trial Secretary's home on Wednesday, September 13, 2006 at 6:30 P.M. Eastern Daylight Time.
- There shall be no refund of entry fees for dogs that are absent, retired, removed, excused or disqualified or if because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or compete in the Trial. If a dog is absent and is replaced by an alternate, then the entry fee shall be refunded.
- Entrants on the alternates' list must check in with the Trial Secretary on the Trial grounds no later than thirty (30) minutes before the commencement of their class. Alternates that do not have the opportunity to run shall have the entry fee refunded.
- Requests to move-up must be given to the Trial Secretary at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the event.
- Bitches in season will be permitted to run in catalog order in Trial classes but will be placed at the end of the running order in Test classes.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$25.00 collection fee will be added to each returned check.
- No refunds will be made for duplicated entries or errors on entry blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such.
- The Kentuckiana Tartan Border Collie Club may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against the Kentuckiana Tartan Border Collie Club or any official, member or agent thereof.
- There will be an hour's lunch break at the judge's discretion each day.
- Please clean up after your dog and yourself. We ask the cooperation of exhibitors in helping to keep the Trial location as clean as possible in order to be able to hold future AKC events at this facility.
- The initial handlers' meeting will be held at 8:15 A.M. each day. Subsequent handlers' meetings will be held before each class.
- A separate entry must be made for each dog.
- All dogs must be held on leash or otherwise restricted except when competing. Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the *AKC Herding Regulations*.
