Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height class, provided that they have earned qualifying scores. Qualifying Rosettes will be awarded to each dog earning a qualifying score. No awards will be mailed.

#### AWARDS

The American Belgian Tervuren Club, Inc. offers the following prizes through the generosity of donors to the trophy fund. All donors' names will be listed in the specialty catalog. All ribbons, awards, trophies, if not awarded in the ring must be picked up by exhibitor. No awards will be mailed.

Trophies for first through fourth place in each class will receive a 5x7 Wooden Picture Frame/Original Design by Joan Smit.

Purina Pet Foods offers to each First Place winner on both days a Bag of Purina Treats & a Tennis Ball Canister.

Award offered by Redwood Tervuren Fanciers (original painting worth approximately \$350.00) for the dog with the highest combined score for all four classes. Ties to be broken first by the highest combined score from the standard classes, then by the highest average (combined) yards per second calculated from the standard class running times, using only the qualifying runs.

#### ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all **Belgian Tervuren** dogs over the age of 12 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dogs physical or mental performance. This trial will be run under the revised *Regulations for Agility Trials* effective September 1, 2002 & subsequent amendments.

#### OBSTACLES

Obstacles shall meet the specification for obstacles in the current edition of the *Regulations for Agility Trials.* 

#### COURSE FAMILIARIZATION/WARM UP

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk through period will be held prior to each class, following the judge's briefing. A warm up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm up area to relieve their dogs. NO NOVICE OBSTACLE FAMIL-IARIZATION EITHER DAY.

#### AGILITY CLASSIFICATION

#### REGULAR CLASSES

**NOVICE AGILITY & NOVICE JUMPERS WITH WEAVES CLASSES** - The Novice Agility Class and the Novice Jumpers with Weaves Class are divided into Division A and Division B. Division A is for dogs that have never acquired any AKC Agility Title. Additionally, a dog entered in the Novice A Class must be handled by a person that has never put an AKC Agility title on any dog, and the handler must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of the owner's household. Handlers that coown a dog and have never put an AKC Agility title on a dog may enter the Novice A Class regardless of the other co-owner's AKC Agility accomplishments. Dogs eligible for Novice A may be entered in the Novice B Class at the discretion of the owner. Division B is for dogs that have acquired the Novice B Class at the Novice Jumpers With Weaves Title, or for persons who have handled a dog to any AKC Agility Title, and for dogs being handled by someone other than the owner, co-owner or household member subject to the restrictions listed above. A dog may continue to be shown in the Novice B Class until they have acquired a qualifying score towards their Open title. Whenever the Novice Class is offered, both Divisions A and B must be offered. **OPEN AGILITY CLASS** - Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility or Open Agility titles, but which have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Agility Excellent title.

**OPEN JUMPERS WITH WEAVES CLASS** - Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice JWW or Open JWW titles, but have not acquired a qualifying score towards an Excellent JWW title.

**AGILITY EXCELLENT "A" CLASS** - Open to dogs that have acquired the Open Agility title, and to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title but that have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Master Agility Excellent title.

**EXCELLENT JUMPERS WITH WEAVES "A" CLASS** - Open to dogs that have acquired the Open JWW title and to dogs that have acquired the Excellent JWW title but have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Master Excellent JWW title.

MASTER AGILITY EXCELLENT "B" CLASS - Open only to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title, and to dogs that have acquired the Master Agility Excellent title.

MASTER EXCELLENT JUMPERS WITH WEAVES "B" CLASS - Open only to dogs that have acquired the Excellent JWW title and to dogs that have acquired the Master Excellent JWW title.

Whenever the Excellent classes are offered both Division "A" and "B" must be offered.

#### PREFERRED CLASSES

All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time **must** enter the Novice level in both the Preferred Standard Agility Class and the Preferred Jumpers with Weaves Class regardless of their previous title level in the Regular Classes (Standard & JWW). There is no grandfathering of titles from the Regular Classes to the Preferred Classes or from the Preferred Classes to the Regular Classes. These classes are separate titling programs and in both cases the dogs **must** start at the Novice level.

**NOVICE AGILITY PREFERRED & NOVICE JUMPERS WITH WEAVES PREFERRED CLASS** - The Novice Agility Preferred Class and the Novice Jumpers with Weaves Perferred Class ARE NOT divided. A dog may continue to be shown in the Novice Preferred Class until they have acquired a qualifying score towards their Open Preferred (OAP) title.

**OPEN AGILITY PREFERRED CLASS** - Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility Preferred (NAP) or Open Agility Preferred (OAP) titles but which have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Agility Excellent Preferred (AXP) title.

**OPEN JUMPERS WITH WEAVES PREFERRED CLASS** - Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice JWW Preferred (NJP) or the Open JWW Preferred (OJP) titles but have not acquired a qualifying score towards an Excellent JWW Preferred (AJP) title.

AGILITY EXCELLENT "A" PREFERRED CLASS - Open to dogs that have acquired the Open Agility Preferred (OAP) title and to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent Preferred (AXP) title but that have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Master Agility Excellent Preferred (MXP) title.

**EXCELLENT JUMPERS WITH WEAVES "A" PREFERRED CLASS** - Open to dogs that have acquired the Open JWW Preferred (OJP) title and to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent JWW Preferred (AJP) title but have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Master Excellent JWW Preferred (MJP) title.

MASTER AGILITY EXCELLENT "B" PREFERRED CLASS - Open only to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent Preferred (AXP) title and to dogs that have acquired the Master Agility Excellent Preferred (MXP) title.

MASTER AGILITY EXCELLENT JUMPERS WITH WEAVES "B" PREFERRED CLASS - Open only to dogs that have acquired the Excellent JWW Preferred (AJP) title and to dogs that have acquired the Master Excellent JWW Preferred (MJP) title.

Whenever the Excellent Preferred Classes are offered both Divisions "A" and "B" must be offered.

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in the Trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher jump height class.

Excellent: Weave Poles • Triple Bar Jump • One Bar Jump

The following obstacles will be used in all JWW Clases:

Weave Poles • Bar Jump • Double Bar Jump

#### In Addition:

**Excellent**: Triple Bar Jump • One Bar Jump Other obstacles as allowed in the regulations

#### AKC HEIGHT CARDS

All dogs competing in AKC agility must present an official AKC Jump Height Card prior to running in any class. **ABTC will accept photocopies of the permanent or temporary height cards for these trials.** Any dogs that have not been officially measured for a Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by the judge of record **prior** to running at each trial. The judge's measurement will be valid for these trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. All exhibitors should carry the original official AKC Jump Height Card with them to each trial, in order to present the card upon request.

ABTC ENCOURAGES ALL EXHIBITORS TO SEND A COPY OF THEIR JUMP HEIGHT CARD WITH THEIR ENTRY or, the exhibitor may present their AKC Jump Height Card at the time of check-in. Those without a Jump Height Card need to be measured prior to judging.

#### MOVE UP

**Prior to the Trial:** Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, **IN WRITING**, (e-mail is ok) not later than noon on **Monday**, **April 28,2003.E-mail requests will be acknowledged upon receipt**.

**Day to Day Move Ups:** Move ups from Monday to Tuesday will be allowed. The request for moving up must be made to the Trial Secretary not later than one hour after the final class on Monday.

#### EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT YOU INCLUDE WITH YOUR ENTRY A STAMPED, SELF-ADDRESSED POST CARD. TRIAL SECRETARY WILL RETURN SAME TO ACKNOWLEDGE YOUR ENTRY UPON PROCESSING. ONLY 10 ENTRIES PER ENVELOPE.

Please include only AKC titles on your entry form. (NO CGC)

Telegraph, telephone, fax, unsigned or otherwise incomplete, or entries without fees cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC agility entry forms or photocopies of the entry forms without the agreement & rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.

Express Mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete, the club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The trial secretary must receive written notification & a copy of the veterinarian's certificate of such a claim for refund by letter postmarked before April 30,2003. A refund check will be sent after the completion of the national specialty.

Make checks payable to ABTC 2003.

Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in US funds. ABTC assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

ABTC may decline any entries & may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, & no one shall have any claim against ABTC or any official thereof.

Errors on entry forms – owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whosoever may make such errors, & no entry shall be refunded in event of such errors, or cancellation of such entries after the closing date. Please type or print carefully the information on the entry forms to eliminate errors.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Agility Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the Agility Trial Committee, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates, except when being judged & in the Warm Up area. Puppies under the age of 6 months are strictly prohibited from the premises.

Safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering the trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with & able to perform obstacles safely.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for returned checks.

At the handler's option,dogs may wear flat (buckle or quick release) collars, but there shall be no hanging tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric & dummy electric collars are prohibited. Food & toys are not permitted on the course area,& handlers are not permitted to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Purina Farms provides large tents at the site. Crating space will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. **No other tenting is permitted** at the trial site.

Exhibitors assume all risk of leaving items overnight. ABTC will not be responsible for any loss or damage to items at the show site.


#### GOOD LUCK TO ALL EXHIBITORS

### DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

**FROM EAST/SOUTH -** Take I-44 to Gray Summit exit 253 (Highway 100 east). Turn north (east) on Highway 100. After approximately 1/2 mile, turn left on Highway MM. There is a small Purina Farms sign on the left-hand side of the road. "MM" is a very winding road - large vehicles use care. Entrance to Purina Farms is approximately 1 mile on the left. Tell the guard you are entered in the agility trial.

**FROM WEST -** Take I-70 to Highway 47, exit 193. Take Highway 47 south to Highway 100. Continue on Highway 100 to I-44 east. Take I-44 east one exit, then exit at Gray Summit. Follow directions as above.

# MOVE UP POLICY: Deadline for move ups is Monday, April 28, AT NOON. Written form must be received by the trial secretary only – NO VERBAL CHANGES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

E-mail changes will be accepted provided all the necessary information is provided with the phrase, "accept this as my signature", & name fully typed out. E-mail move ups will be sent a reply, if you do not receive one – call or mail a move up form in.

Day-to-Day move ups at the trial will be allowed provided that the request is made in writing to the Trial Secretary at the end of the class judging on Monday. Forms will be available from the trial secretary. No verbal or e-mail move ups will be allowed the weekend of the trial.

# AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying Dog Shows" and the "Regulations for Agility Trials" have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC approved judge, judging at this trial, under AKC rules, regulations and guidelines. I (we) agree that the club holding this Agility Trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Agility Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or trial secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the agility trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim;and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or be alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.
