### ADDITIONAL TRIAL REGULATIONS

We ask the cooperation of exhibitors in helping keep the trial location as clean as possible in order for us to retain the use of this facility for future tests and trials.

No refund for duplicate entries. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Entries must be received at the Trial Secretary's address by the published closing date to be acceptable, and may not be changed, substituted, corrected, signed, or cancelled after that time except as provided in Chapter 3, section 1, of the *General Regulations for Herding Tests and Herding Trials*. Incomplete, unsigned, conditional, telephone and telegraphs or entries recieved without fees are not acceptable. **Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.** The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in being put on a cash only basis.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries must be on the enclosed blank or a reasonable facsimile thereof.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian, judge or tester or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund will be made.

Dogs must be ready for their classes. Trial judges have the authority to refuse to judge any dog, which does not appear within five minutes of being called for its run. The trial giving club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

The club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

Any rules or regulations of civil authority must govern exhibitors, building and parking restrictions. Vehicles parked contrary to regulation will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.

Only dogs eligible to be entered at this Test/Trial will be allowed within the Test/Trial limits except that testers/judges may use a trained backup dog in settling or controlling the stock.
